



INNOPROM GOLF CHALLENGE 2019

Local Rules

1. Out of bounds (Rule 18)

The ball is out of bounds when it is:

- behind a boundary fence,
- inside construction or technical areas;
- behind white stakes.

2. Abnormal course conditions (Rule 16)

Ground Under Repair

- White-lined areas.
- Seams of turf cut (not the turf itself) in general area (except when they interfere with the player's stance).
- Parts of fairways without turf, larger than scorecard length (not divot holes).
- Washed out areas of turf near the drainage wells.

The ball may be dropped within one-club length of the nearest point of complete relief, located not nearer the hole, in accordance with Rule 16.

Immovable Obstructions

- all artificially surfaced cart paths.
- young trees (staked and wired or shorter than 1.5 m, or dug around).
- sprinkler heads of irrigation system, covers of drainage wells.

If an immovable obstruction interferes with the position of the ball or the player's stance or swing the ball may be dropped without penalty within one-club length from the nearest point of complete relief, not nearer the hole, in accordance with Rule 16.

Immovable Obstructions close to Putting Green

If a ball lies in general area and an immovable obstruction on or within two-club lengths of the putting green and within two-club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b

3. Integral parts of the course

All woodchip covered areas are integral objects – unless they have been white-lined. (Individual pieces of woodchip are loose impediments and may be removed).

4. Penalty areas (Rule 17)

The red penalty area on the right of the hole 10 is considered to be extending to the right for an infinite distance.

Dropping Zones

If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the penalty area on holes 1, 8 and 12, the player may under penalty of one stroke:

- Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
- As an additional option, drop a ball in the dropping zone. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3

5. Tees and starting times

Amateurs: men - **white** tees, women - **pink** tees;

Professionals men - **grey** tees;

All groups tee off simultaneously from different holes by a horn signal (Shotgun start). Starting groups and holes are set by the Committee.

8. Additional Contests

Longest drive:

- men - Hole 10;
- women - Hole 1.

Nearest to the pin:

- men - Hole 17;
- women - Hole 8.
